MERIT CRITERIA

1. A Math

- At least a pass in Math

MERIT CRITERIA

Out-of-Stream subject

1. Art/ F&N/ D&T @ 'O' level

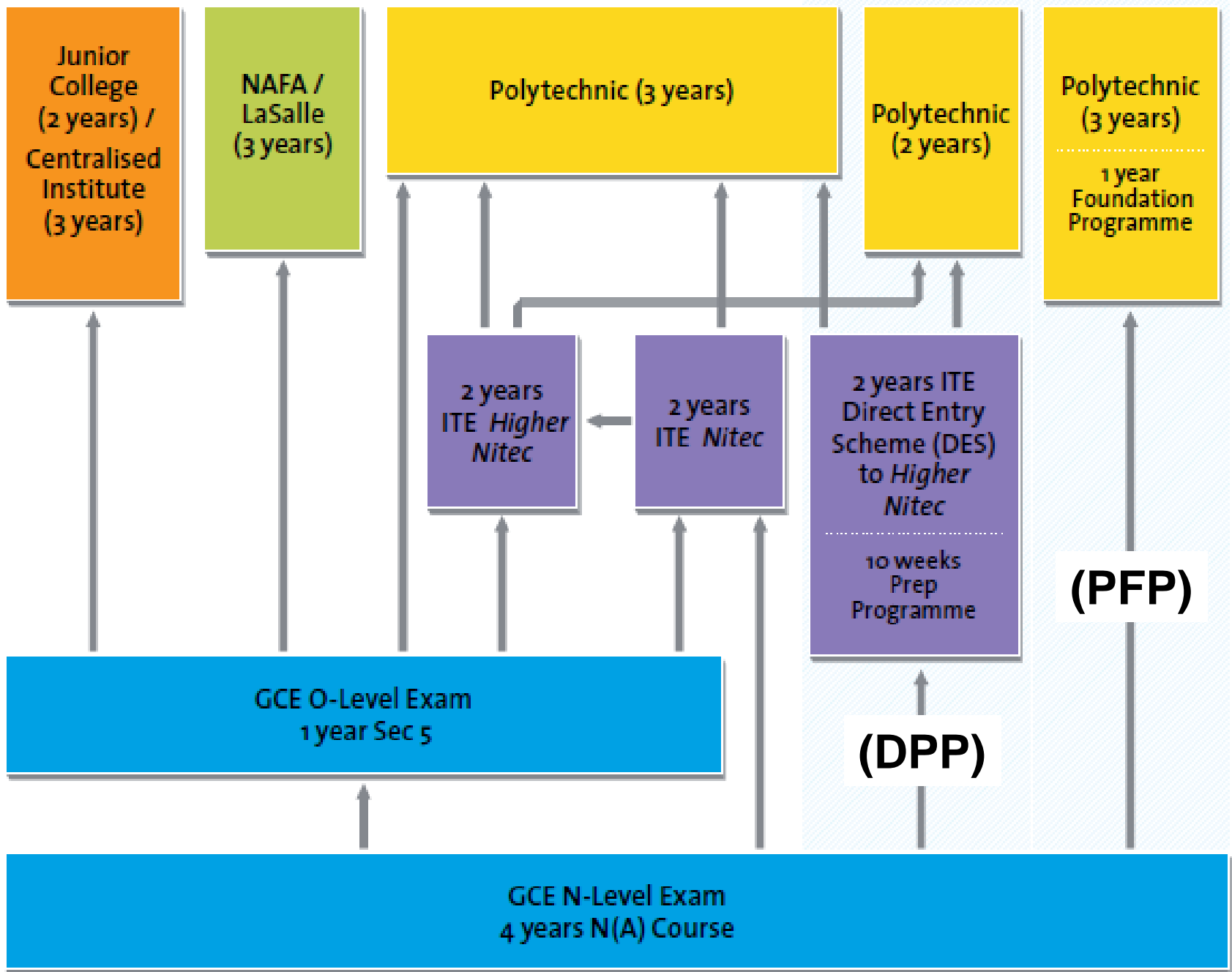
- Attain at least 80% in the subject in their Secondary 2 overall results;
- Show consistency in performance in the subject at Secondary 1 and 2;
- Attain passes in at least 5 other subjects with an overall average percentage of 60% and above in their Secondary 2 overall results; and
- Attain at least a 'Good' conduct grade in both SA1 and overall at Secondary 1 and 2.

(after GCE “N” Level Exams)



* Progression to first-year and second-year Polytechnic Diploma course from ITE Higher Nitec is based on merit.

Direct Polytechnic Admission– **DPA**

Purpose:

- For N(A) students who are:
 - academically strong,
 - clearly polytechnic bound and
 - blended learning styles (conceptual and applied)
- **DPA Exercise takes place in July**

Polytechnic Foundation Programme – PFP

Purpose:

- For N(A) students who are:
 - academically strong,
 - clearly polytechnic bound and
 - blended learning styles (conceptual and applied)
- The 1-year FP will prepare students for entry into the 1st year of pre-selected polytechnic diploma courses

Criteria: ELMAB3 of 11 points or less

ELMAB3 = English + Mathematics + Best 3 subjects

Aggregate of **11 points or less** & **EL, MA** \leq 3

Good to note – Bonus points for CCA grades can be used for ELMAB3 computation:

- *CCA grades of A1, A2 – 2 points;*
- *CCA grades of B3, B4, C5, C6 – 1 point*

Direct-Entry-Scheme-to-Polytechnic (DES-to-Poly) Programme (DPP)

Purpose:

- For N(A) students who are fairly strong academically
- Skills training and experiential learning at a ITE Higher Nitec programme.
- Students who achieved the qualifying ITE Grade Point Average (GPA) will be admitted into the 1st or 2nd year in a polytechnic diploma course related to the Higher Nitec DES Programme

Direct-Entry-Scheme-to-Polytechnic (DES-to-Poly) Programme (DPP)

Criteria: ELMAB3 of 19 points or less

ELMAB3 = English + Mathematics + Best 3 subjects

Aggregate of **19 points or less** & **EL, MA \leq 4**

Good to note – Bonus points for CCA grades can be used for ELMAB3 computation:

- *CCA grades of A1, A2 – 2 points;*
- *CCA grades of B3, B4, C5, C6 – 1 point*

Admission to Sec 5 to take O level

- **Purpose:** provide students who are likely to do well in the O levels a pathway to the Junior Colleges or alternative pathway to the Polytechnics

Criteria: ELMAB3 of 19 points or less

ELMAB3 = English + Mathematics + Best 3 subjects

Aggregate of 19 points or less & EL, MA \leq 5
